

APGMWR Outdoor Recreation Picnic Area Rules



- Please be aware: If you have not reserved the entire facility then there may be other customers utilizing 1. the area. For reservations at Shore Park, if you have not reserved all 3 pavilions, there may other customer at the remaining pavilions, each pavilion holds 100 people.
- Patrons are responsible for leaving the pavilions a clean condition, free from any debris or litter. All trash 2. and disposable items must be carried out or placed in the centrally located dumpster. It is advised to bring additional trash bags to compensate for excess trash.
- All charcoals must be cooled and discarded properly in the designated areas. 3.
- Shore Park bathrooms must be left in the same condition they were when you entered the facility. 4.
- Music must be played at reasonable noise levels so not to disturb other picnickers/residents/facility users. 5.
- 6. All picnic tables must be placed back in the designated pavilion in the way in which they were found.
- NO pets are permitted at the picnic areas. 7.

Staff Verification:

- Park in designated areas only. Shore Park- blocking the entrance to the swimming pool or parking on 8. School Street (housing area) is prohibited. Park area is shared with campground patrons.
- Any guest without a Government ID must get a visitors pass when entering APG at gate 715 Visitor Center. 9. MWR is not responsible for extended wait times at the gate because of non eligible ID holders. Refunds will not be provided for extended wait times.
- Users of APGMWR Picnic Areas and its amenities do so at their own risk. 10.
